3. Election Rules and Regulation: -

The election of DPSU will be governed by the following rules & regulation.

1. The candidate has to be regular student and must have attendance above 70% in all the previous semesters.
2. A candidate must take admission in respective semester.
3. The candidate must not have been involved in, or have any record of, unfair means in examinations, destruction or damage to college property, violation of college rules and regulations, or any other form of misconduct.
4. A candidate can contest for only one portfolio.
5. A candidate will not be entitled to contest for any portfolio if any criminal record accorded against him/her.
6. Hanging of poster on the Academic Building wall (Inside & outside) during election is strictly prohibited.
7. Uses of fire crackers and any other objectionable items are strictly prohibited within the Institute premises.
8. No campaigning shall be allowed at a radius of 50 meters from polling booth on the day of polling.
9. Use of loudspeakers, vehicles, etc. for the purpose of canvassing shall be prohibited.



10. All candidates shall be jointly responsible for ensuring the cleaning up the institute campus within 48 hours to the conclusion of the polling.
11. Only admitted students can cast their vote with Proper Identity and College Uniform.
12. The candidate asking for nomination must have proper Identity proof.
13. **No campaigning in private hostels, Paying Guests etc. after 6 pm. Candidature will be cancelled if campaigning is done as such.**
14. Violation of the above rules and regulations will result in strict action and cancellation of candidature.
15. No outside organization is allowed to participate in the election process.
